Jack Wait, who worked on the location of the two end points for Boulder Dam while engaged in engineering work during the construction days, is a Boulder visitor from Pasadena, vacationing here and renewing friendships of other days.

Wait, the first Boulder City man to try for a legislative position in 1932, is now in business in Pasadena, a business similar to some of the work he did at Boulder, being a manufacturer of concrete products.

He worked on driving of diversion tunnels, high scaling, concrete work, locating of the railroad to the gravel pit, and locating of the highway to the dam, being on the project from 1929 to 1935.
