Yep, Apple Pies Are Made from Apples Grown in Yards by Boulder Folk

Yep, apples can be grown in Boulder City.

They're being grown here this year and apple pies have been made from them.

This information popped into the News office by phone last evening.

Mrs. Tony Gally, 660 Avenue G, has grown more than a bushel on a tree in the family yard, and has made pies from some of them.

Leon Elkins has grown four apples on a tree at his home at 652 Avenue G.

And Lucille Pease has grown apples at 625 Avenue L.

Though apples are far from being among fruits best adapted to this desert country, they can be grown here as pointed out in a recent news item in another paper, which told about those grown at 625 Avenue L.

Figs, oranges, apricots, peaches and many other fruit trees have been grown here, figs being among the most successful.

The Elkins and Gally apples grew on trees about five to seven years old.
