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- 6. The leases referred to are the two which include the two parcels occupied by the bosel, and the lease covering the vecent parcel which is although (April 21), 1938 of Arizona street from the front of the house.

Subject: Request of Hotel Holding Corporation for 20year lease for Boulder Dam Hotel - Boulder City - Boulder Canyon Project.

- 1. Reference is made to the Commissioner's letter of July 21, 1937, to the Secretary; to the Chief Engineer's letter of July 1, 1937, and to the Construction Engineer's letter of June 23, 1937, to the Commissioner through the Chief Engineer, above subject.
- 2. July 27, 1937, the Secretary approved the recommendations set forth in the Commissioner's letter of July 21.
- 3. August 12, 1937, this office issued a circular letter "To all permittees operating business leases in Boulder City", stating: "If satisfactory service is rendered during the life of the present permit and if the lease conditions have been faithfully followed, extensions up to 20 years may be made; and under these contracts the Bureau of Reclamation will reserve the right to review and revise compensation due the Government to be more in conformity with the present National Parks contracts operating in this area."
- 4. Copies of this circular were transmitted by the Acting Construction Engineer August 12, 1937.
- 5. Hotel Holding Corporation now requests extensions of its existing leases at this time; it does not wish to wait for such extensions until these leases expire--as contemplated in the Commissioner's letter and in our circular, referred to above. Copies of the letter addressed to

This office April 13, 1938, by Vice-President Sidney Bazett of Hotel Holding Corporation, are enclosed. It will be noted that not only does Mr. Bazett request extensions now, but asks that the period of extension shall run 20 years from June 30, 1941.

- 6. The leases referred to are the two which include the two parcels occupied by the hotel, and the lease covering the vacant parcel which is situated immediately across Arizona street from the front of the hotel.
- 7. Of course, if Hotel Holding Corporation is to be accommodated with extensions at this time, the same privilege should be accorded to other permittees who hold business leases expring Jume 30, 1941.
