

Hazel Lueking Died at Care Center in St. George

Hazel Lueking, at the age of 88, died in St. George of a prolonged illness. She was the widow of Carl Leslie Lueking who preceded her in death in 1958. He is buried in the Boulder City Cemetery.

The Luekings were well known in Boulder City. Carl had worked as a pipe fitter at Hoover Dam, 1931-35. He was a Charter member of the American Legion Post 31. Hazel belonged to the auxiliary. They were members of the Community Church and most of their years together were spent in Boulder City.

Hazel was the last of a family of 8 children.

Her brother, Fred Holland Sr. worked on the dam. Her mother, Mrs. John Thomas Holland, came to Boulder City in 1931 and was associated with the Community Church even before there was a building.

Hazel's father, died in 1906, and her mother died in Boulder City.

Hazel was a volunteer all her life. She will be buried by the side of her husband at the local cemetery. Services will be held in Salt Lake City. A memorial fund has been established at the Community Church.
