

J. HEBER RICHARDS

DIES WHILE INSPECTING

PROSPECT ON COLORADO

The family of J. Heber Richards, (familiarily known as "Joe" Richards) were deeply shocked today by the receipt of a message announcing his death from sunstroke yesterday afternoon. Mr. Richards, at the time, was on the Colorado river about 25 miles from Las Vegas, Nev. He was a member of the mining firm of the Taylor-Richards company and had gone to the Colorado with B. H. Vincent of this city to inspect some deposits of manganese ore. The dispatch announcing the death gave no details.
