

Injuries Fatal To Boulder Man

Roy Fairbanks, 74, of Boulder City, died last night in a Downey, California, hospital from injuries sustained September 24, when he was struck by a car as he crossed a street in that city, it was revealed today.

One of the pioneer residents of Boulder City during the dam construction era, Fairbanks was the builder of the Emporium and Men's store in the damsite city.

In 1939 he sold the Men's store to R. L. and R. W. Georgeson, and started traveling extensively
