

# John P. Walkers Leaving Boulder

Leaving Boulder City Saturday for Florida where they will make their home will be Mr. and Mrs. John P. Walker of 633 Avenue B and residents here since 1944.

Until his retirement in 1946, Mr. Walker was the senior metallurgist at the Bureau of Mines, on leave from the Anaconda Copper Co.

He had been granted a leave of absence from Anaconda in 1942 and after two years of research and operation connected with sponge iron production, was appointed assistant in the original titanium pilot plant at Boulder City.
