

# City May Expand Its Borders Now With New Plan

Boulder City's water-supply troubles will be all over by next spring.

The Bureau of Reclamation promises that not only will the new water supply line from Hoover Dam be completed before next summer, but that additions and improvements to the water-treatment plant, designed to increase substantially the capacity of the plant, will be completed by April of 1949, well in advance of the hot summer season.

Six pumping units for the new supply line already have been received on the project, and the building for the booster pumping station is virtually completed.

## 2nd Stage Later

Senator Pat McCarran, who has been trying to speed up progress on improvements and additions to the Boulder City water system, said that in addition to the first-stage improvements to the Boulder City water treatment plant, which are now promised for com-
