6. Exterior appearance:
Construction material: planed lumber between back bedroom windows, all outside walls 8 inch, red, fire brick. Sand and gravel mortar was used, type of nails - 10d. ten penny. Roofing: all roofs covered with 2 layers of asphalt-saturated felt roofing, this is covered by Spanish type Clay roof tile.
There is one fire place with one chimney. The chimney is made of cement-lime mortar and 8 inch red, fire brick. Flues are lined with fire-clay flue lining, and it is installed with ventilators.
