

Boulder Bowl Bowling Alley Has New Owner

Taking over as owner of the Boulder Bowl Jan. 1 was Art Jory, southern Nevada resident for the last seven years. Jory purchased the bowling alley from Folke Hermanson.

Jory said the only change in policy will be that the alley will be open daily from 1 p.m. instead of 4. Closing time will depend on the bowlers. The new owner said he also plans to keep the alley open during the Summer months.

Located at 504 California, Boulder Bowl has eight alleys and cost per frame is 35 cents.

For the last two years, Jory and his wife, Laura, and two sons, David, 13, and Douglas, 5, have lived in Las Vegas and for five years prior to that resided in Henderson. Until purchasing the bowling alley, he had been employed since 1950 by General Auto Works.
