

DEER ON TOM HOLLAND'S NEW RANCH IN UTAH

Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Holland and sons, Carl Edgar and Carroll Thomas, left Tuesday morning to make their home on the ranch which they recently purchased in Escalante valley, about 38 miles from Cedar City. The ranch contains 160 acres of irrigated land, and it is rumored that a number of their friends, including Chief C. F. Peterson and Garold Nellis, expect to hunt deer on the ranch.

The Hollands have lived in Boulder City since 1930, Mr. Holland having worked on the construction of the dam. He was a captain on the Bureau of Reclamation ranger force before entering the service three years ago, from which he was discharged a few months ago. They resided at 634 Avenue D.
