

F. B. Polley, Former B. C. Resident, Dies

Word has been received of the death of F. B. Polley, former resident of Boulder City, in Missoula, Mont.

Death came last Friday, a day after Polley suffered a stroke.

Among the survivors are his widow, Albertine Polley; two daughters, Mrs. James (Marguerite) Manix, Augusta, Mont., and Mrs. Thomas (Moroa) Ames, who now lives in Japan; a son, Foster Polley, of Las Vegas; several grandchildren, brothers and sisters, and children by a former marriage. Both Mrs. Manix and Mrs. Ames are well known here, being former residents.

Polley was a school principal before coming here. While he lived here he worked at Boulder Dam. He and Mrs. Polley moved away about two years ago.
