

DR. J. McDANIEL RE-OPENS OFFICE AT BOULDER CLINIC

A very popular physician and surgeon has returned to Boulder City recently — Dr. John Riley McDaniel Jr. He is associated with the Boulder Clinic and the Boulder City Hospital.

Dr. McDaniel is an Easterner and he came to Las Vegas to establish a practice in January, 1931. In May of 1932 he came here during the construction of Boulder Dam. He remained until 1938 and returned to Las Vegas where he became one of the owners of Las Vegas Hospital, the only hospital in the city at the time. Southern Nevada Memorial Hospital was an old peoples' home. He had the oldest practice in Clark County also.

McDaniel is a graduate of New York University and Bellevue Medical Center, now a part of the university. His internship was spent in New York

City Hospital. Since then he has taken advanced courses in cardiology back at the university and chest diseases at Saranac, N.Y.

He saw active duty in the European theater of operations in the United States Air Force for three years and seven months during World War II and his retired status is that of Lieutenant Colonel.

He has a married son, James, an architect in Las Vegas, who made him a very happy grandfather in November. The child is a little girl. His daughter, Miriam, named for her mother who passed away, is a junior at Cornell University.

Dr. McDaniel stated he was very happy to be back and when asked if he had noticed any changes, he said, "Only this those who were having babies when I was here before, are now having coronaries."
