BOULDER CITY — The Department of Interior has honored engineer Leon E. Sullivan upon his retirement after 23 years of federal service, all with the Bureau of Reclamation, Regional Director A. B. West announced yesterday.

West presented Sullivan with the department's commendable service award recently at a party at which co-workers honored the retiree, and his wife, Nella.

Sullivan was an engineer in the hydrology branch in the division of project development on Reclamation's Region 3 staff in Boulder City at the time of his retirement. The division is headed by regional development engineer N. E. Pelham.
