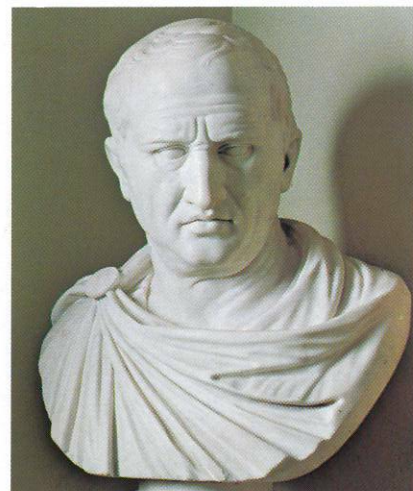

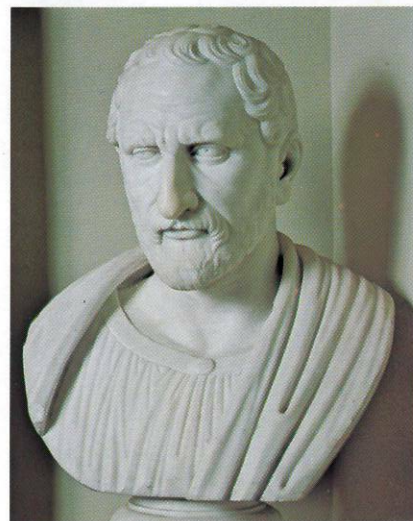

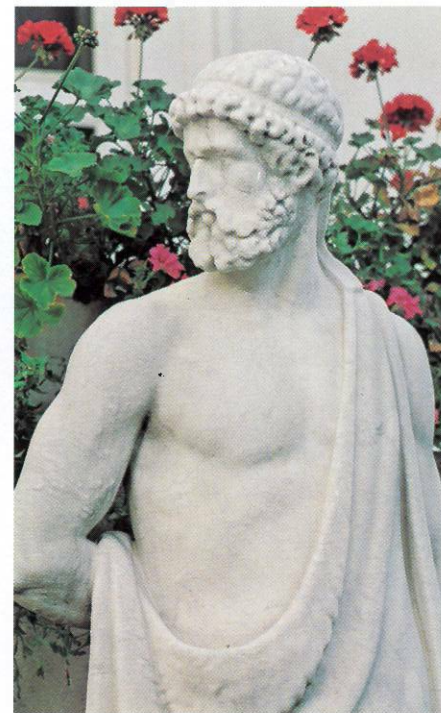
The Belmont Estate was noted for its statues inside the mansion and on the grounds. In 1866 Adelicia procured in Italy *Sans Souci* by Chauncey B. Ives (A) and the *Sleeping Children* by William Rinehart (C). The former statue is in the possession of Dr. Oscar F. Noel, Jr., while the latter statue is in the mansion. Lions still guard the steps on the driveway (B), and *Arno*, a copy of a sculpture by Horatio Greenough (D), continues to grace the grounds.

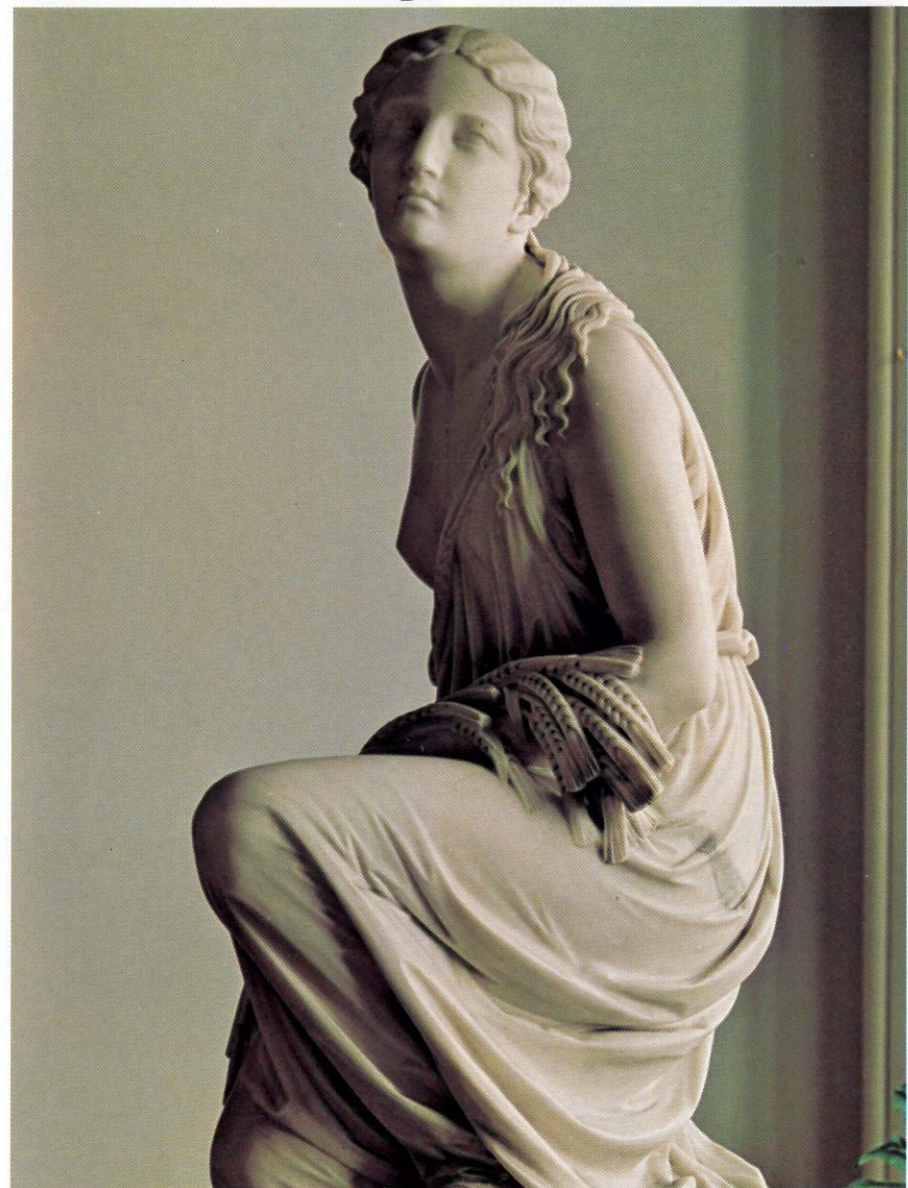

Adelicia also purchased in 1866 *Ruth Gleaning* by Randolph Rogers (A) and *Rebecca at the Well* by Chauncey B. Ives (E). *Ruth Gleaning* is the one statue which has always remained in Belmont Mansion, while *Rebecca at the Well* was later returned. The busts of Demosthenes (B) and Cicero (C), Acklen pieces, are in the possession of Dr. Oscar F. Noel, Jr. A statue of Hercules (D) continues to stand outside the mansion.
