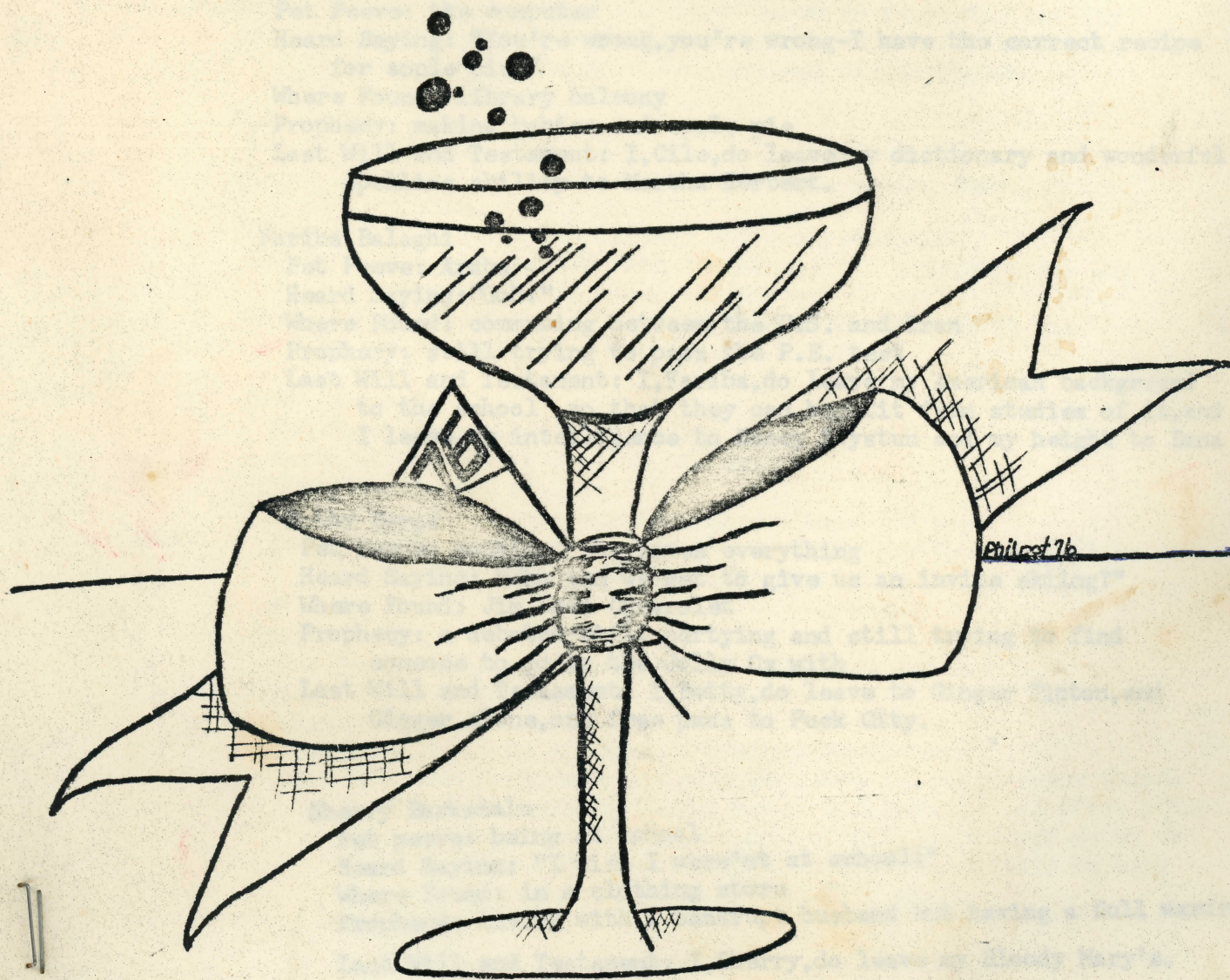


A TOUCH OF Senior Class
