FAVORITE WARD-BELMONT RECIPES

In response to many requests for Ward-Belmont recipes, we shall print a "favorite" in each issue of the *Journal*.

SALLY LUNN

- 2 eggs
- 1 cup sugar
- 3 cups flour
- 3 tsp. baking powder

- 1 cup sweet milk
- 2 Tb. butter

Cream butter, add sugar, and cream together. Beat yokes of eggs and add to the butter and sugar mixture. Sift flour with baking powder and stir into the first mixture, alternating with milk.

Last, fold in beaten egg whites. Bake in greased layer pan at 375°. Eat with butter while hot.
