***What I remember best about my Ward-Belmont days...**I was a day student at Ward Belmont. Most of my friends were day students and are all dead now. World War II was quite an experience for me. I learned to fly and was separated a year from my husband. He came back to the U. S. because his ship was blown up in the North Sea and he almost lost his life. Mr. Bray died in 1995. I live alone now. My daughter (Mrs. Lee Hilton) lives in Fredericksburg VA. My daughter Bonnie Clapp lives in Atlantic Beach. I have 4 grandchildren Amanda Thomasson, Alice Williams, James Williams and Shannon Clapp.

***Where my life has taken me...**I went to George Peabody College for a degree in Physical Education. I married Bun B. Bray in 1936 and lived in Nashville with my parents for 1 ½ years while teaching Phys Ed for girls at Vanderbilt

University. We went to Raleigh North Carolina where I taught Phys Ed at Needham Broughton High School for 6 years. War came and I belonged to the Civil Air Patrol. Joined Wasp and went to Texas for training, my husband was a Navy Lt. Col. I left Wasp and went to work at Boeing Aircraft as expeditor. When my husband came back to the States he was transferred to New York where I joined him. I worked for the Army getting train reservations for Army personnel.
