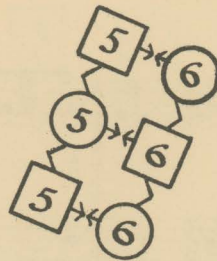
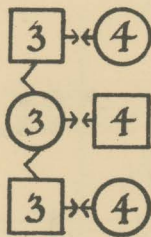
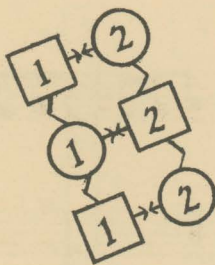


## No. 2.—THE DASHING WHITE SERGEANT OR HIGHLAND REEL



MUSIC.

MOVEMENTS.

Bars.

In groups of six round the room

No. 1 facing No. 2. No. 3 facing No. 4 and so on.

1-4      Six hands round

5-8      and back again.

9-10     The centre man and woman set to woman and man on their right.

11-12   and turn them.

13-14   Then set to woman (or man) on the left,

15-16   and turn them.

17-24   Reels of three—(The three No. 1's, three No. 2's, etc )

*Center turns R-passes R  
shoulders then he -*

25-28   Each triplet taking hands, they advance and retire.

29-32   Advance again through the opposite three, passing right shoulders, and meet the next triplet.

**NOTE**—This can be danced either with each triplet composed of a man and two women, or, a man between two women, facing a woman between two men.
