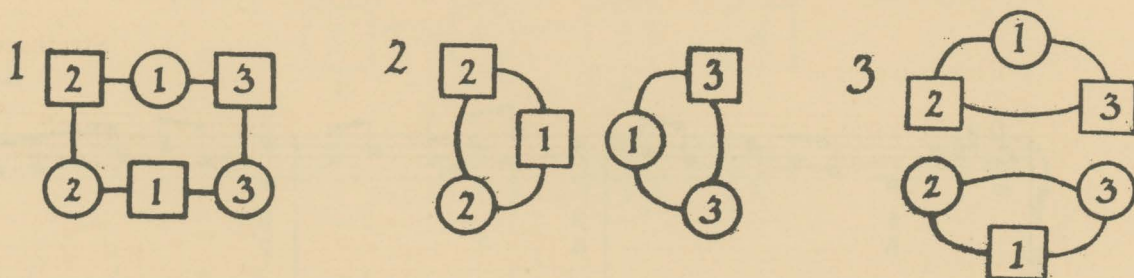


No. 9.—LADY MACINTOSH'S RANT  
or  
THE DUKE IS WELCOME TO INVERNESS



On second chord first couple change sides, where they remain till they reach the bottom of the dance.

MUSIC.

MOVEMENTS.

Bars.

- 1-2 First man and woman cast off one place,  
3-4 and turn with right hand ;  
5-8 cast off again, and turn with left hand.  
9-12 Lead up to top and cast off one ; second couple move up  
13-16 First three couples six hands round (Fig. 1).  
17-20 { First woman three hands round with the second couple.  
          { First man three hands round with the third couple (Fig. 2).  
21-24 { First woman three hands round with second and third men.  
          { First man three hands round with second and third women (Fig. 3).  
25-28 First couple lead through third couple, and cast up one.  
29-32 First and second couples right and left at top.

Repeat having passed a couple.

*NOTE.*—When the leading couple reach the bottom of the dance, with only one couple below them, they finish by dancing again, bars 1-4, casting off one, and turning to their own sides below the bottom couple.
