### STARTING AND FINISHING SIGNALS

Exactly five minutes before the start of a race a siren shall be sounded and the four black balls on top of the time clock shall be raised. Balls shall be lowered as each minute passes and exactly sixty seconds before the start a warning gun shall be fired, a white flag raised and the clock set in motion to indicate the passage of the last minute. At the finish of the minute the white flag shall be dropped and a starting gun fired.

### FLAGS

A yellow flag raised indicates the start of the final lap. A checkered flag indicates the finish of the race. A red flag raised indicates a false start. Rapid waving of the red flag is a signal for all boats to clear the course by reason of accident or other incidents.
