SUBJECT: Property numbering and street naming east of Lynn Creek.

At the request of property owners in the Deep Cove and Dollarton areas, we now have under way a house renumbering study covering the whole of the area east of Lynn Creek. This work should be completed within the next few days.

When new numbers have been allocated and put up by the property owners affected, the Post Office has indicated that it will, within two or three months thereafter, institute improved postal delivery service which, in some areas, will involve door to door delivery.

In this area there are a number of conflicting street names - as well as confusing and conflicting numbering service, and it seems appropriate that street names be changed where necessary at the same time as number changes are being effected.

Attached for your information is a report from the Street Naming Committee consisting of Messrs. C.E. Davis, M. Chesworth and A.W. Hopen. I asked these members of the staff to review the names of the streets in the eastern part of the District with a view to determining which streets should, at this time, be considered for renaming.

It is proposed that this Committee tentatively select names for the streets or portions of streets which they suggest should be renamed and that the appropriate Ratepayers' Associations be contacted to review the renaming proposals and if they wish, to submit alternate names. These in turn will, of course, have to be checked against the metropolitan directory so as to avoid any further confliction.

There will, undoubtedly, be a certain amount of opposition to this proposed program, but it should be minimized in view of the improved mail service in the offing.

Once the ratepayers have been given an opportunity to express themselves in regard to the proposed renamings, we would draft an appropriate by-law for Council's consideration.

As I would like to use the Building Department's staff to implement this renumbering and remaming program during the relative lull before this year's construction season opens up and because I am sure the property owners affected will be very eager to receive improved mail service as soon as possible, we are endeavouring to deal with this program as expeditiously as possible.

May I have your Committee's approval or comments on this proposal.

BY-LAW NO. 2660

A By-law to name and re-name certain streets in the District of North Vancouver.

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to name and rename certain streets lying within the limits of District Lots 624, 626, 543 and 575 in the vicinity of Deep Cove and Cove Cliff;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of North Vancouver, in open meeting assembled, hereby enact as follows:

(1) That the schedule annexed hereto, marked Schedule "A", is a plan of streets which shall be designated

as:

Roxbury Road
Lockehaven Road
Eastridge Road
Summerside Lane
Naughton Avenue
Kinloch Road
Raeburn Road
Cliffmont Road
Rockeliff Road
Panorama Drive
Cliffwood Road
Gallant Avenue
Stonehaven Road
Eastleigh Lane
Banbury Road

- (2) That the streets shown in Schedule "A" annexed hereto shall be named in accordance therewith.
- (3) That the Municipal Engineer is hereby authorized and instructed to erect signs on the aforesaid streets indicating the names assigned thereto pursuant to this By-law.
- (4) This By-law shall come into force and take effect on and after the 1st day of September, 1960.

This By-law shall be known and cited for all purposes as "DISTRICT OF NORTH VANCOUVER STREET NAMING BY-LAW NO. 1, 1960".
