have been having felons.

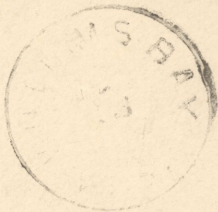
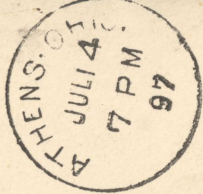
Well the conference is
