I am sending you some records that I have found. You might already have what I am sending, but in case you don't, here it is.

The same day I received your letter, Mrs. Marlys(Lambert) Stuart and her husband were in our library researching the Lamberts. They were interested in the line of Abner Lambert, who I believe was a brother of your Benjamin. Her address is Box 21, Buckingham, Iowa 50612.

Benjamin Lambert was b. ca 6 Mar 1783 in Hyde Co., N. C. of Quaker parents.

He emigrated to Ohio about 1800. Married Catharine Brill, ~~MM~~ in Belmont

Co. She was born in Pa. and died 8 June 1850 in Morgan Co. *They had 9 children.*

12 Aug 1836 Abner Lambert of Belmont Co. bought land from Pearson and
Syntha Vore of Marion Twp.--Deed Book W, Page 452--160A in Range 12, Twp.8,

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Section 13--also recorded in Athen Co. Records--Volume 7, Page 930--value \$60 Northwest quarter of Section 13 or Lot No. 13 in the Ohio Co. Purchase. Ebenezer Dorr had originally drawn the land. Further description may be had in the Survey Books of the Ohio Company.

1863 Abner Lambert et al to Jesse Hiatt Book 8, Page 427--35A in Range 12, Twp. 8, Section 13--the ones who signed the transaction were Abner Lambert and wife Martha; John Davis and Ruth, and Ann Davis.

September 27, 1899 Chesterhill items -- Morgan Co., Herald
Cale Lambert died 17 Sep of Typhoid, b. Bethel. C. E. Lambert returned after hearing his brother Cale was worse and he arrived too late for funeral.

R. B. Lambert intends to break up housekeeping. Mr. and Mrs. Lambert are going to Tracer, Iowa where they will spend the winter with their son Chalk, Elza will attend the Columbus Law school and Mayme the Marietta business college.

Benjamin Franklin Lambert was born 19 Aug 1822 in Belmont Co., Ohio He came to Morgan Co. with parents in 1835. First settled near Reinersville, married Martha Willey of Belmont Co., Nov. 28, 1850. Martha, one daughter and two of 3 sons survive. He joined M. P. church at Seeleyville in 1870, In 1871 he changed to Cross Road Presbyterian Church. He died 25 May 1898

Page 116--" Catharine Brill was the daughter of Christopher Brill of Guernsey Co. His will is in Guernsey Co. (Will Book A, page 15, names of his children and their spouses will be found in Deed Book J., page 348"

This is the Catharine who married Benjamin Lambert in Belmont on 15 Feb 1810.
