"The friends appointed in the case of Henry Doudna report they had an opportunity with him to a good degree of satisfaction believing his request to be on the ground of convencement. He is therefore on solid consideration received into membership and Jesse Bailey and William HODgin are appointed to inform him thereof and report to next meeting."

"Thomas Edgerton having to this meeting acknowledged himself justly disowned by Deer Creek monthly meeting and requested to be again united to friends, wherefore Jehu Middleton and Henry Stanton are appointed to visit him on the occasion, feel after the sincerity of application and report to next meeting."

"The friends appointed in the case of Thomas Edgerton report they have visited him to a good degree of satisfaction and believe him to be sincere in his request; wherefore on deliberation consideration this meeting is free he be received into membership provided Deep Creek monthly meeting shall have no objection thereto; And the clerk is directed to forward a copy of the minutes in his case and sign it on our behalf."

"The friends appointed to enquire into the clearness of Joseph Edgerton report they find nothing to prevent his proceeding in marriage with Charity Doudna, they are therefore left at liberty to accomplish the same and Joseph Garretson and William Patterson are appointed to attend thereat, produce the certificate to next meeting and report whether good order has been observed."

"The friends appointed to attend the marriage of Joseph Edgerton and Charity Doudna report they attended and have produced the certificate."

"Isaac Coppock requests to be released from being a member of friends society, this meeting grants his request, and Isaac Shotwell is appointed to inform him thereof."

"The friends appointed in James Nichols case, report they had an opportunity with him to a good degree of satisfaction, and think it best to continue it, it is therefore left under their care to report to next meeting."

"Concord Preparative Meeting informs that William Wells requested to be joined in membership with friends, therefore Benjamin Vail, Abner Lambert and Benajah Steele are appointed to visit him and report to next meeting."

1805 22nd of 1st mo
