

RECORD OF THE LAMBERT FAMILY IN THE U.S.A.

(Compiled by William Otterbein Lambert. Part of this information was copied from a book brought to Ohio from North Carolina. Part on the Stanton side of unknown origin, but possibly part of it from Grandfather Lambert. The Embrees were French; they escaped the Huguenot persecution, went to Holland and on to Philadelphia and then some on to Ohio. The French is L'Embree which was shortened to Embree in this country)

JOHN LAMBERT: He was a great grandson of JOHN LAMBERT, the leading General in Cromwell's army. He was born in 1715. His wife was Elizabeth Sayes (born 1716). Their children were :

Sarah, 1738; Moses '40; Aaron '43; Jesse '45; Abner I, '46;
ABNER II '47; John and Hannah '53; Elizabeth '55; David '57;
All lived at Elizabethtown, New Jersey. JOHN LAMBERT himself had seven sisters and seven brothers.

ABNER LAMBERT II Born 1747; married Maggie Hughes (born 1751) in 1774. Children were John and Matthew. ABNER'S second wife Winifred Cartwright, (born 1750) and moved to Mattem arket, North Carolina. ABNER and Winifred were married in 1780.

Their children: Jesse 1781; Benjamin '85; Albert '86; Elizabeth and Orlate '88; ABNER '90; Daniel '82; Annie '95. ABNER married again in 1811 to Susanah Fairies. (TWINS?)

ABNER LAMBERT born 1790. Married Elizabeth Stanton (born 1798) in 1817. Their children: Hannah 1818; Joseph '20; Barclay '25; Elwood '28; Mary '31; Abner, '33; DANIEL WEBSTER LAMBERT '37; Reece, '38; Elizabeth '43; (W.O.L.'s personal note: I remember well my grandmother (Elizabeth) Lambert. She died about 1892. She taught me to knit when I was a boy; also to spin. I have a photograph of the old house with the big chestnut trees and remember once in being in her home before she came to live with her children).

REV. DANIEL WEBSTER LAMBERT was born 1837; was married to Deborah Vernon Embree (born 1840) in 1858. Their children: Ida 1859; Eva '61; Frank '63; Alva '65; Hannah L. '67; D. Ira '70; Bertha E. '72; William Otterbein '75; Carolyn D. '77; Elsie M. '80.

★ IDA E. Married Jordan T. Harris, 1879. Children were James Arthur Harris and Nellie Harris. Both were married and raised seven children. Arthur became a great scientist, specializing in Botany and the laws of heredity of plants. Was responsible for the development of hybrids in corn, wheat, oats and barley.

EVA N. Married S. V. Selby about 1880. Children were Grace, Alice, Bertha, Paul and George. Grace has ten children; Alice one, and Paul two.

FRANK died of diphtheria in 1880.

ALVA E. married Nellie Randall. Children were Glenn, Clair, Frank, Ralph and Marie.

HANNAH L. married the Rev. J. C. Mayne. Children were Horace, Dwight, Helen, Daniel Ira and (Rev.) John C.

X BERTHA E. married (Rev.) Joseph H. Harris. ^{Five} children: Paul, Robert, Daniel, Theodore, James and Richard. ~~Eight~~ grandchildren.

(REV.) DANIEL IRA married Emma Brown. Children Natalie and Ruth. Each have two children.

CAROLYN D. married Oscar H. Charles, 1901; Children Philipp and Daniel. Four grandchildren *Elsie Caroline*

WILLIAM O. married Loretta Adams in 1900. Children: Pauline, Mary Lucile and Charles O. Three grandchildren.

These children and grandchildren are all making their way in a competitive world, without help from society. All have blessed the communities in which they have lived. Some have become nationally famous. No millionaires!

ELSIE M. married (Rev.) Wallin Riebel in 1903. They went as missionaries to Africa where Elsie died in 1903. She was a martyr to her love for God's work.

RECORD OF THE STANTON LINE

ROBERT STANTON (born 1599) and his wife Avis. Robert Stanton was reported to be one of the signers of the Mayflower Compact. Their children were Robert 1627; Mary '42, Sarah '40; JOHN 145; Daniel '48. Mary was whipped out of Boston about 1658 for being a Quaker.

JOHN STANTON married Mary Horndale, 1667. Children were: Mary 1668; Hannah '70; Patience '72; John Jr., '74; Constance '75; Robert '77; Benjamin '84. JOHN STANTON then married a second wife, Mary Cranston, widow of Governor John Cranston. Their children were Mary 1708 and HENRY.

HENRY STANTON born 1688; married Mary Hall in 1707. Children were Mary 1708; Alice '09; Margaret '12; Calheme '13. Second wife was Lydia Albertrous. Children by second wife: Benjamin, Sarah, Avis and HENRY, JR.

HENRY STANTON, JR. married Catherine Bufort. Children were Mary and Catherine. Second wife was Hope Borden, 1754. Children: Hope, Ruth, William, Benjamin, Barclay, JOSEPH, Abigail. They lived at Cortoreb County, North Carolina. *Carter*

JOSEPH STANTON married Hannah Bundy. Children were Hope, 1795; Joshua '97; ELIZABETH, '98; Peniah, 1801. ELIZABETH was a first cousin to Edwin M. Stanton, a member of Abraham Lincoln's cabinet.

ELIZABETH STANTON married ABNER LAMBERT in 1817. Their children: Hannah '17; Joseph '20; Barclay Elwood '22; Abner '33; DANIEL WEBSTER '37; Reese, '38 and Elizabeth '43.
