for many years. Last four years almost helpless - Could
not dress or get into or out of bed - Priscilla Palmer
waited on her - Could sit and knit, used a quill
to hold the knitting needle - Strict disciplinarian in
the home - called mammy -

Died Nov 26, 1849 - ^{aged 65} - 2 mo - 26 days. at
home of daughter Sydney Harris Baldeason on Bald Eagle
Creek two miles North West of Winden (Stockport).
Buried at Pennsville Ohio in Friends' graveyard -
Grave is numbered (My father John W. Harris visited the
grave)

All children dispossessed of inheritance in Friends'
Church unless it were Jonathan who named a Friend
