I am fortunate enough to own a copy of History of the Presbyterian Church at Westfield which had belonged to Mr. John Frazee, noted local historian. In the book were these typewritten pages as well as many notations and underlinings, some of which I ^{can} have xeroxed for you,

I have a copy of Roger Lambert and Descendants which is possibly the book that one of your members mentioned. I have indexed it but do not have the index typed yet. When it is ready I will send you a copy. It was written by Ira C.
