





Rev. D. W. Lambert, Westerville, Ohio, was called aloft on January 5, a few days less than eighty-one years of age. For some reason, we did not learn of his decease at the time. He and his good wife had spent almost fifty-nine years of wedded life. Among the children are Mrs. J. H. Harris, wife of our pastor at Fifth Avenue church, Columbus, Ohio, Mrs. O. H. Charles, of Tagbilaran, Philippine Islands, and Rev. D. I. Lambert, of Rushville, Indiana. Mrs. Elsie Lambert Riebel, another daughter, wife of Rev. Wallin Riebel, pastor at Logan, Ohio, died in 1903 in our African mission field. Brother Lambert was a member of Southeast Ohio conference, an active itinerant more than forty years, traveling some of the most difficult fields. No hardships were too great, no conditions too severe to interfere with his pastoral duties. In one revival campaign, he preached seventy consecutive evenings. He recognized the value of collegiate training, as shown by the college work of a number of his children. When he realized that the end was near, in the presence of his loved ones he sang, "All the way my Savior leads me," then prayed for his wife, his children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and closed with the words of Jesus, "Father, into thy hands I commend my
