Johns Hopkins, a very able and successful merchant and banker, left half his fortune to the founding of this University. The University was incorporated August 24, 1867, and its official name is The Johns Hopkins University.

The Board of Trustees held their first meeting February 6, 1874, and on December 30 of the same year elected as president Daniel Coit Gilman, then president of the University of California. Dr. Gilman was the ablest educator of his time and the broad basis of the university and its comprehensive policy was due very largely to his vision. The result was that Johns Hopkins was acclaimed the first real university in America.
