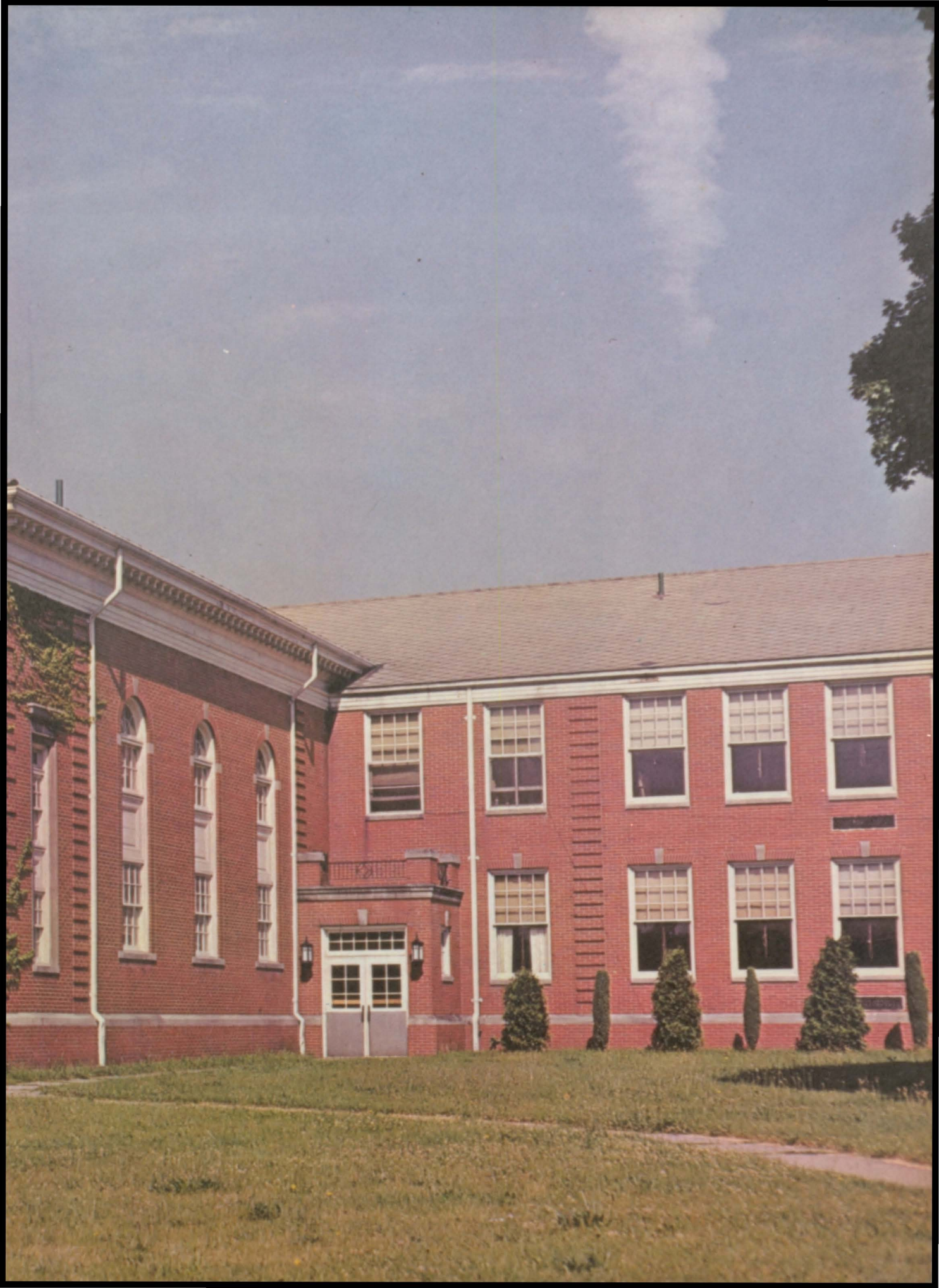


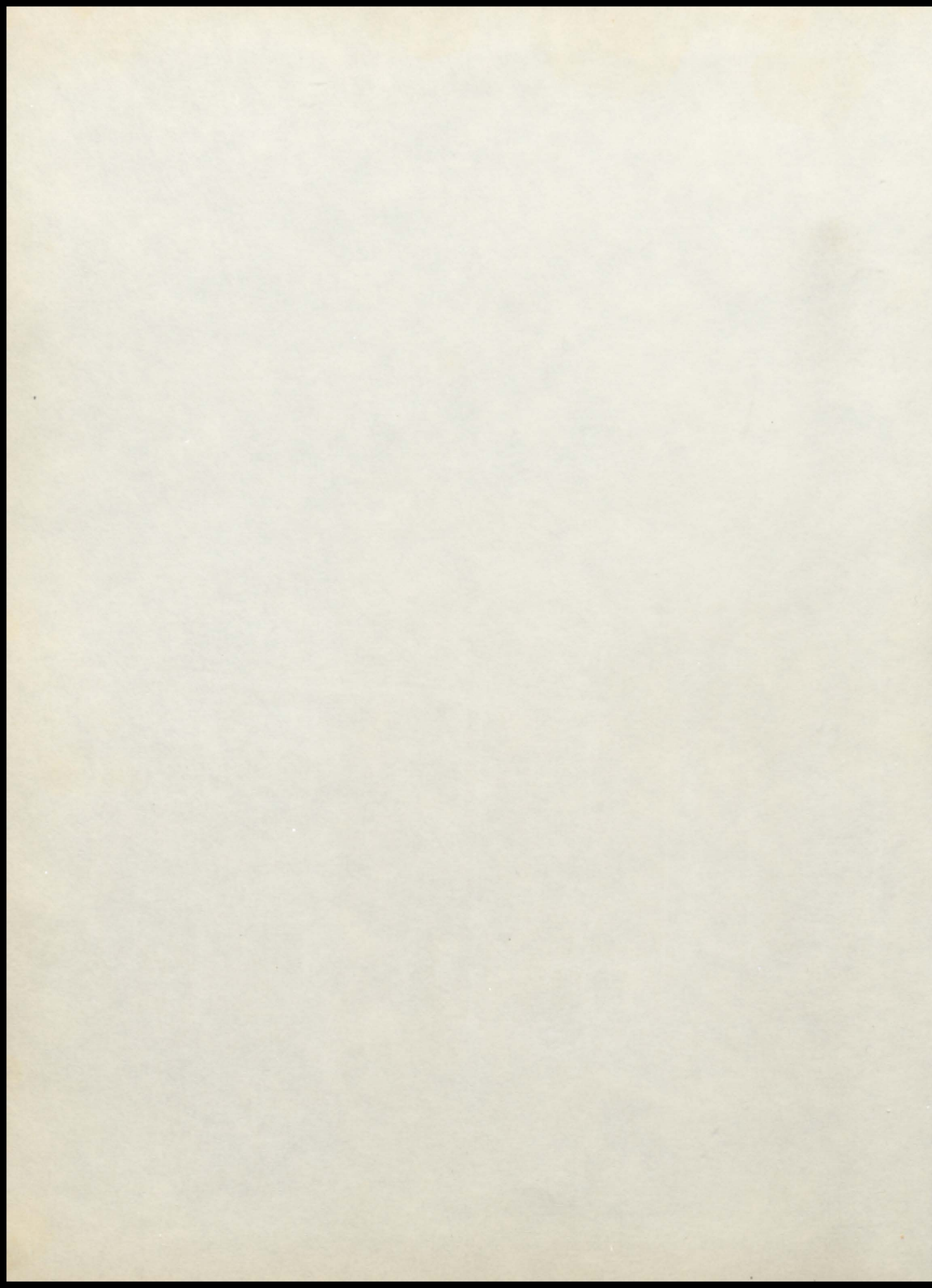

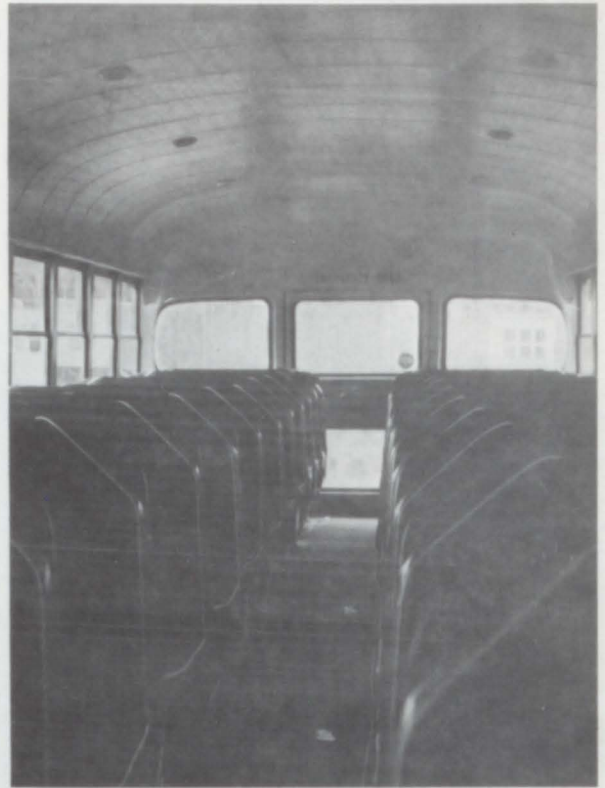

Commencement, however means the beginning. For some it is the beginning of additional education and training, and to others it means the beginning of their contact with the business world.

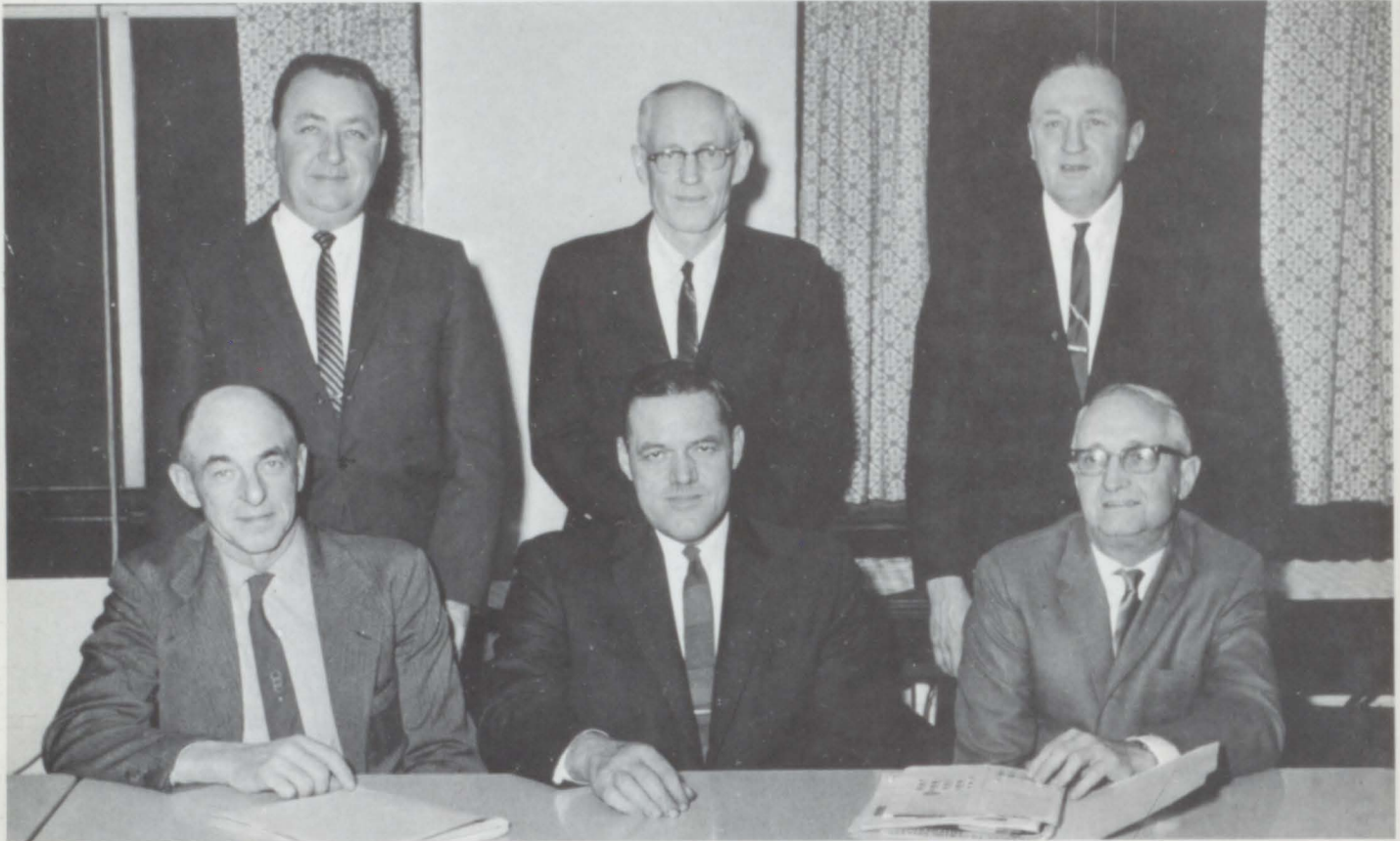
