

## In Memoriam



Robert K. Mellinger

Robert K. Mellinger, Principal of Badger High School, died on Monday, October 25, 1971, following a brief illness.

Born October 16, 1931, in Akron, he was the son of Kenneth and Mabel A. Richardson Mellinger, who survive. He also leaves a sister, Mrs. Dale Krauss, who was a substitute teacher at Badger during the 1970-71 school year.

A graduate of Erie (Pa.) Academy, Mr. Mellinger received his bachelor'e degree from Thiel College and his master's degree in mathematics from the University of Utah. He had also studied at Westminster College in their graduate program. Parents and students of the Joseph Badger School System remember him in many positions. He was a math teacher in the Hartford school before consolidation; and when Badger High School opened its doors that fall of 1960, Mr. Mellinger was there to inspire his many math students to do excellent work. He was a highly respected teacher in the Badger system until June 1967 when he made the decision to teach in the Howland system. Badger High students and parents were pleased when he accepted the position as principal in January 1969. Even during his short illness, he returned to the school on Saturday, October 16, to work so that the school would be a more pleasant place for the students and teachers.

Mr. Mellinger had been a very active person in the community and in the professional world. He had served in the Armed Forces from August 1953 through July 1956, was a past president and secretary of the Trumbull County "AA" League, had served on numerous math committees in Trumbull County, was the present secretary of the Trumbull County Secondary Principals' Association, and had for many years been an official basketball scorer for the Northeast District Class "A" Basketball Tournament. He was a member of the Association of Secondary School Principals, the National Association of Secondary School Principals, the Ohio Education Association, the Zion's Reformed United Church of Christ, Greenville Lions Club, Italian Home Club, National Council of Teachers of Mathematics, Phi Delta Kappa, honorary men's education fraternity, and Sigma Phi Epsilon, social fraternity.

Those of us who had the pleasure of working with Mr. Mellinger in the Joseph Badger School System will continue to feel the presence of his guiding hand. It can be said about him in ultimate eulogy, "He was truly a great teacher."
