Mr.Jones has been our guide, counselor, and teacher for the past six years. He has always been willing to give us a helping hand when assistance was needed.


Through his association with the class, our lives have been brighter, our load a little easier. He has instilled within us a desire to accomplish that which is for a better and fuller life.

And the best of us all go under—


And whether we're wrong or whether we're right,
We win, sometimes, to our wonder.


Here's luck!
