Even though we will miss him we wish him well in all of his future plans.

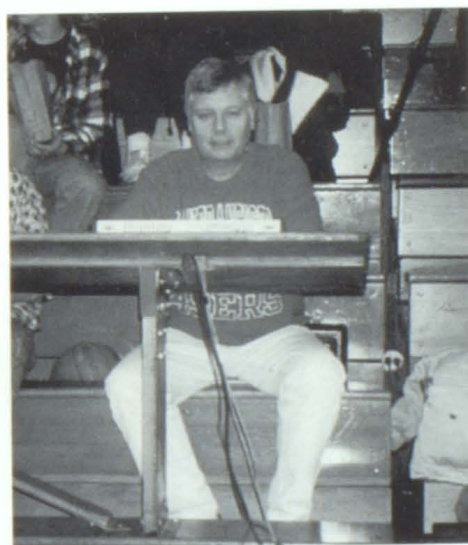

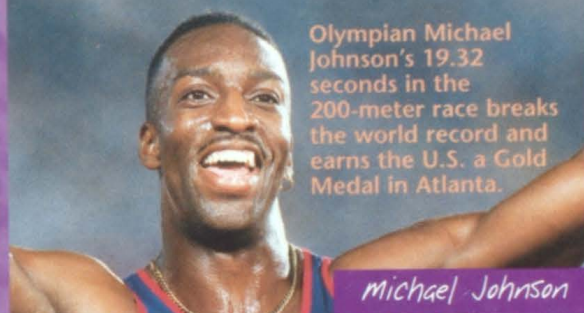
