I am asking for a small information as to who Louis Robidou a merchant in Santa Fe in the 20's and thirties married left there in 1844 for Riverside California with his wife and family. it is the wife name I have in mind it may be Garsiga Guadalupe or Guadalupe Garsiga =

Antoine Robidou his Brother also a trader in furs having the Robidou trading Post on the Gurnison in Colorado. Carmel Benavides in 1828 married M<sup>rs</sup> Antoine Robidou a French trader she was born in Santa Fe on the 29<sup>th</sup> of Dec 1812. the Benavides were and old and aristocratic Spanish family. as I understand the father was Governor of New Mexico
