A deputation of the ladies is expected to arrive in this city on Thursday to complete the arrangements. It will be remembered that the parish of St. Patrick's Church has already raised quite a sum for such a building, and it is more than likely that this amount will be used in erecting the building, which will cost about \$20,000.
