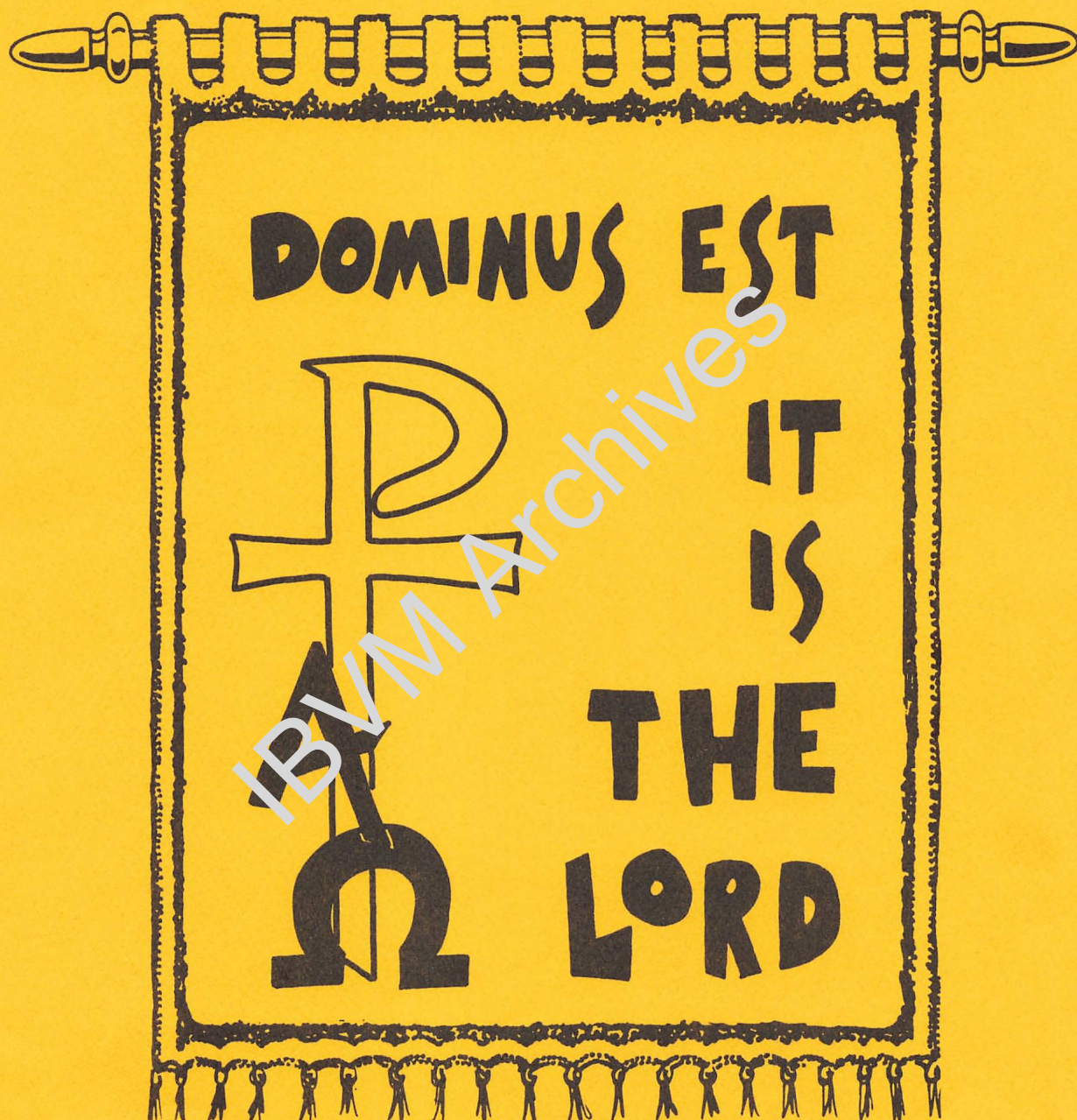

bless, now, our sister-in-Christ.

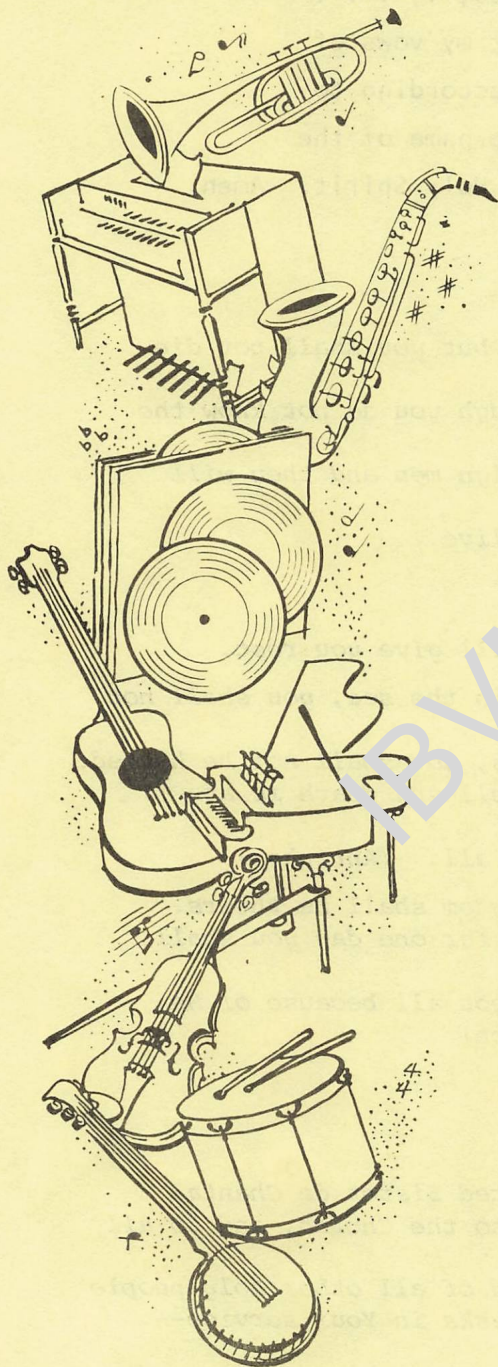
By living a dedicated life she seeks the coming of Your Kingdom here on earth.
