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Constitution.

Loretto Alumnae of St. Bernard's Chicago

Article I - "Name."

This organization shall be called
"The Loretto Alumnae of St. Bernard's ^{English} - Chicago."

Article II - "Object."

The object of this Association shall be (a) to maintain and perpetuate the memories and friendships of school girl days at St. Bernard's, and to strengthen the ties that bind them to their Alma Mater; (b) to promote the interests of St. Bernard's Schooling; and (c) by mutual encouragement in living as true Christian Women, to honor their holy Patroness, Our Lady of Good Counsel.

Article III - "Officers."

Section I The officers shall be a President, Vice

President, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary and Treasurer, whose duties shall be such as usually pertain to such officers. Elections shall be by ballot seven members to constitute a quorum.

Section II

In the absence of the President her duties shall be performed by the Vice President.

Section III

The term of office shall be one year.

Section IV

All business transactions and important proceedings of the Association shall be subject to the approval of the Superior of Loreto Convent, St. Bernard's, Chicago, and the Principal of St. Bernard's High School.

Article IV "Membership"

Section I

None but Graduates from St. Bernard's High School shall be eligible for membership.

Section II

Eligible candidates shall be admitted to membership at the Annual Meeting.

Section III — The fee from each member shall
be One Dollar, payable on or before the
date of the Annual Meeting.

Article V — "Meetings."

Section I — There shall be ~~three~~ regular
meetings held in the year, viz: in ~~Nov.~~ ^{Nov.}
~~February~~ and June. The Annual Meeting
at which the enrollment of new members
shall take place shall be held in June
as soon as possible after the commencement
of Exercises at ~~La Salle Academy~~ —

Section 2 — Special Meetings shall be called
by the President on application of four
members. All members to be specially
notified of the proposed meeting.

Section 3 — All meetings shall be conducted
by the rules of Parliamentary usage, as
laid down in "Robert's Rules of order".

Article VI — Amendments

The Constitution may be amended

at any regular business meeting of the Alumnae, by a two-thirds vote of the Members present, provided a written notice of the intended change has been given at least two weeks previous.

Amendment I.

There shall be a yearly Mass on Decoration Day for deceased members.

Amendment II.

The annual sum of ten dollars has been appropriated for the purpose of donating the Christian Doctrine Medal to the High School. This medal will be known as the Loretto Alumnae Medal for Christian Doctrine.

amendment III

~~Pupils who have attended St. Bernard's
High School for two years, shall be
admitted to the Alumni, as "Asso-
ciate Members", without any rights
of vote, or to hold office.~~

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
