Most Rev Edward Dingley D.D.
Most Rev and dear Father

Yours well, doubtless
remember two of our Sisters calling
on your Grace, last September, to
represent our inability to supply
all religious teachers in the
Parochial schools of Folke

At that time we offered to share
the work with any other
Community coming, and are
still willing to do so, but
Rev. F. Murray, Pastor of the
Mary's, object manifested that
his Community would come
under those conditions.

We have no fault to find
with the Rev. Pastor, who has
been uniformly kind to our

time, too with the place in which
we have labored for over a
quarter of a century, with, we
trust, results pleasing in the
sight of God. but we cannot
promise to provide all religious
teachers, as we are obliged to
engage some secular help in
all our Schools. Trusting
that your Fatherly wisdom
may instruct us what to do

And praying God to bless you
in all your work this New
Year, And with best wishes.
