Pledge Sunday April 28

The Joliet Diocesan Appeal, the annual fund raising effort that underwrites more than 75% of the diocesan budget, begins on April 21, Appeal information weekend, and culminates on pledge Sunday, April 28.

Bishop Joseph L. Imesch has appointed Appeal leadership and met with parish committees throughout the Diocese to stress the importance of the campaign.

Father Dominic Valentino, pastor of Visitation Church in Elmhurst, is the priest chairperson of the '91 effort. Named to assist are lay leaders Wayne Huffman, Cathedral of St. Raymond, Joliet; Bill Pyle, Maternity BVM Church, Bourbonnais; and Frank Slauf, St. Petronille Church, Glen Ellyn.

In making the appointments, Bishop Imesch praised the energetic leadership of the '91 team. "Each member of the team brings a wealth of experience and support to the Appeal. We are blessed to be able to select from so many dedicated Appeal workers."

Funds raised through the Appeal are used to underwrite on-going programs and services of the Diocese, including Catholic education, charities, leadership training and spiritual formation programs. The 1991 Appeal video showcases these varied programs and how they impact on individual parishes.

Parishioners will be asked to make a pledge over eight months through an envelope received at all the Masses on the weekend of April 27/28. Follow-up to those not responding will come from the parish in mid-May. To reach all registered Catholics who have not yet responded, a phonathon will be conducted from May 27 through June 14.

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Take care of him, and if there is any expense over and above, I will repay you on my way back" (Lk 10:35)

That short but familiar statement from Luke's story of the Good Samaritan captures what our Diocesan Appeal attempts to do.
