Officers


Section 1. The officers of this society shall be He to ry President, President, Vice President, Recording Secretary, and Treasurer.

Article V.

Membership

Section 1. Mothers, guardians, and friends of the Academy students, the Alumnae, and all interested in the Ladies of Loretto are eligible for membership.

Section 4. Membership shall be terminated by formal resignation or for non-payment of dues.

Article VI.

Dues

Section 1. The club year shall be same as the calendar year. Annual dues shall be \$2.00, payable in advance.

Article VII.
