ST. MARY'S ACADEMY is situated in the City of Joliet, about thirty miles southwest of Chicago, Illinois, and is within easy reach of the railroads entering the city. This Academy is under the direction of the religious of the Institute of the Blessed Virgin (usually known as the Ladies of Loretto). Their system of education aims at developing side by side, the moral, and the intellectual faculty of the student.

The Academy was chartered under a general law of the State of Illinois, November 6, 1882; in 1892, accredited relations were established with the DeKalb Normal School, and in 1903, with the University of Illinois at Urbana.

The Course of Studies is threefold: Academic, Commercial and Preparatory.

The Academic Course embraces the usual branches of a liberal education.

The Commercial Course embraces not only the fundamental branches of Mathematics and

English, but also the Commercial Specialties, Penmanship, Bookkeeping, Shorthand and Typewriting.

The Preparatory Course gives a thorough foundation in all elementary branches.

Special time and attention will be given to pupils desirous of obtaining a teacher's certificate.

Music, in its various branches is assiduously cultivated. The Scientific, Vocal and Instrumental Departments are taught by accomplished and experienced teachers, whose system is modeled on that of the European Conservatories.

The instructions in Art are thoroughly practical and useful. The studios for drawing, painting, carving, etc., are large, well-lighted and thoroughly furnished with copies, models, etc., and are open for students at all times.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS.

1. The annual vacation commences the last week of June, and the scholastic duties are resumed the first Tuesday in September.

2. Pupils are received at any time of the year, their session dating from the day of entrance. Difference of religion is no obstacle, but Non-Catholic Students must be willing to attend the public exercises of religious worship.

3. No reduction is made for pupils withdrawn before the end of the session, unless in case of dismissal. If withdrawn on account of sickness, the pupils may after recovery return to finish their term.

4. No jewelry should be brought to the Academy.

5. References are required before the admission of a pupil.

6. All articles brought by pupils should be marked in full.

7. All letters sent or received by the pupils are subject to the inspection of the Superioress.

8. Each pupil should be provided with a dressing sacque, four changes of linen, six towels, four table napkins, one white and one black Brussels net veil; length, two yards for black, and three yards for white; knife, fork, table and teaspoons, work-box and dressing case furnished; four sheets, four pillow cases, comforter, pair of blankets, rug, note paper and postage stamps. The uniform for Sunday is black Casmere, plain white linen collars and cuffs.



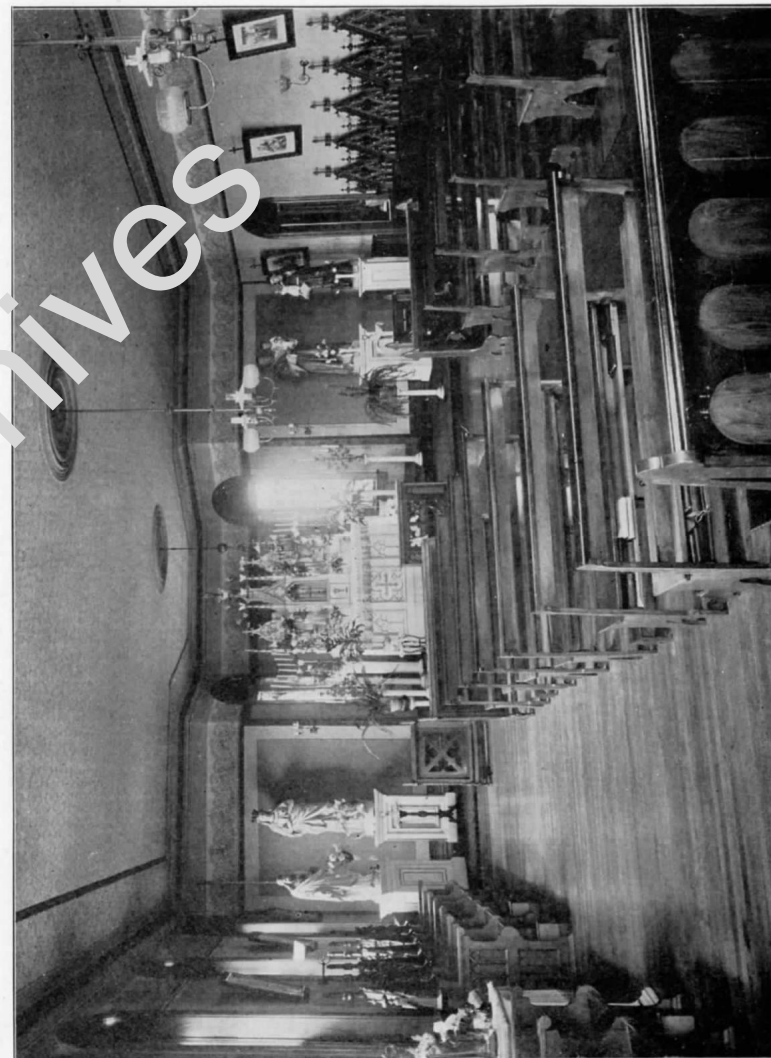

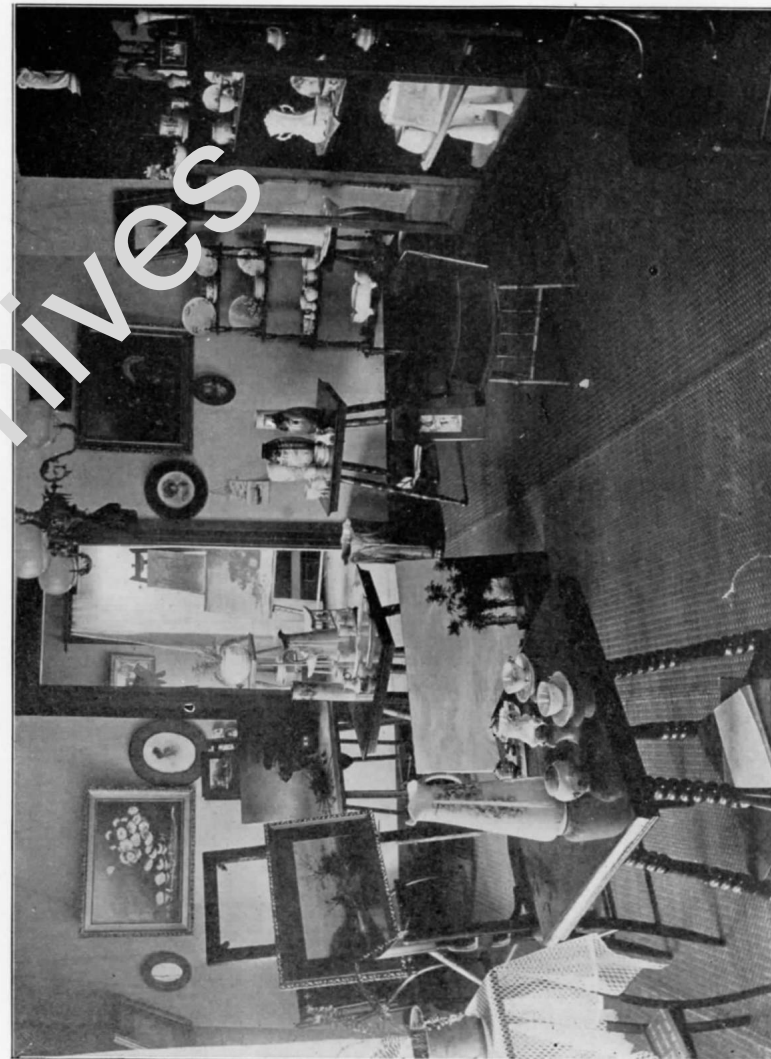
