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ABSTRACT: Frank Augustus Seiberling (1859-1954) was the co-founder of Goodyear Rubber and Tire Company. He was born in Western Star, Norton Township. He married Gertrude Ferguson Penfield in 1887. Later in life he was also the founder of Seiberling Rubber Company. The materials within this collection pertain to all aspects of F.A.'s life. The collection contains personal documents, correspondence, business records, financial records, etc. The materials were collected and gifted to Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens by an unknown source.

¹ The majority of the documents in these boxes were business records created by Willard Seiberling, not F.A. Seiberling. It is unclear how these records came to be obtained by Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens. As these materials focused primarily on Willard Seiberling and the Seiberling Rubber Company with a secondary focus on F.A. Seiberling, the decision was made in 2023 to remove these boxes from their original order in the F.A. Seiberling Collection and reorganize them as the Seiberling Rubber Company Collection. In April 2025, the SRC Collection was reintegrated into the F.A. Seiberling Collection as a Series to retain the original intent but aid findability for researchers.
