DESCRIPTION: (Looking from south Terrace to Garman Rd.) Wide allee between rows of tall, branchy (sycamore?) trees in full leaf. Allee begins in foreground across entire bottom of canvas and ends at center-left midground. The end is an undefinable lighter green and some blue. Trees visible all the way to end on right side but not on left. Behind trees are an abundance of fuschia and white rhododendrons in full bloom. They extend to end of allee. Small patches of sky visible at top of canvas. Two, long dk. blue shadows lie across allee at center.

CONDITION AND ALTERATIONS: Wrapped. Unvarnished. Overall surface dirt. 5 keys missing. Needs backing board. Bottom & right side (left on back) stretchers reinforced with cross brace tacked at back side. Middle of tree trunk- left foreground paint loss, possibly puncture. Some paint flaked off at bottom, center-left.
