Simple Thoughts on the Theory of Dowsing.

Dowsing is the visible effect of an invisible force field and there are too many people who can dowse/divine for there not to be a logical explanation.

The world is reckoned to be 4,540,000,000 years old give or take a few thousand million. In that period it has seen ten or twelve major changes with numerous hundred million year Ice Ages, tsunamis or overheated earth surfaces and at least two periods when an estimated 98% of all living organisms were wiped out.

Under the fairly shallow hard surface of the planet, there is a massive molten mass which was responsible for the volcanic activity throwing up magna to be subject to repeated cycles of glaciation and thaw and eventually producing multi-layered surface to The Earth which various pundits have likened to an onion.

As well as the wonders on the surface of the Earth, this molten mass has also produced forces which we can't see but can prove their existence where their visible effects can be shown. Four centuries of experiment and debate have produced the theory of an electromagnetic spectrum which emerges from this molten centre.

These works can vary from finding that light can be split into seven parts, to being able to see and speak directly to people in Australia. Whether you can see them or not, electromagnetic forces have moulded our world and the living organisms there including humans.

## Dowsing/Divining.

Dowsing was first known to be used when Moses used his divining staff to find water in the desert and is still used by farm workers, drainers, plumbers, road workers and water diviners who can find bodies of water hundreds of feet below the surface.

But how does it work? Nobody really cares, they just know it does through positive results. Having experimented with everything from rubber gloves/boots, sheets of corrugated iron and a piece of string, it was only the string which produced a positive result.

A. When a man or woman walks over a piece of ground, they see or feel nothing unusual despite the fact that they are absorbing an invisible electro-magnetic force.



B. When a man or woman walks over a piece of ground which has a filled-in ditch, posthole, grave or the foundations of a building under the surface but nothing is visible, they still feel or see nothing untoward. For comparison think of an encased clock with no hands; the clock still works but it can't be seen or heard working.



C. However if the man or woman walks over the same ground (B) holding divining rods they move, usually crossing but with some cases separating. As the person moves away from above the ditch/graves etc, the divining rods point forward again. This is equivalent to adding hands to the clock – something that can be seen.

So what makes the difference? The electro-magnetic force coming from the molten centre of the world changes as it passes through the layers of earth. After digging through several feet of naturally packed soil, the infill is never as tightly packed and this could create a vent to allow a marginally different strength of the force. Does this make it stronger? I don't know.

Experience and experiment has made me aware that the change does not depend on where the feet are but rather where the hands are. Standing on the edge of a drain with the divining rods near your chest and they still point forward; move your hands forward a few inches and they cross. This would indicate that the invisible force was strongest directly above the edge of the drain.

In trying to break down the component parts of electro-magnetism, I have tried many experiments with a number of materials to no effect; with rubber gloves/ boots or a corrugated iron sheet over the covered drain and there is no effect – the rods still cross.

However if I hold a piece of string in both hands while trying divine, I can cross the drain and the rods do not move from the straight forward position. Trying the same with wire, various metals and wood, the result was the same. Obviously the piece of string was blocking the electromagnetic force absorbed in my body from getting as far as the divining rods, ie the string was completing the circuit before the divining rods. But string does not conduct either magnetism or electricity so is it a different force within the electro-magnetic spectrum?

It is my contention is that dowsing locates intrusions in the normal ground surface pattern but it needs metal divining rods, hazel twigs or plumb weights for us to see where they are.
