My dear Doctor Robinson:

Enclosed please find requisition for one International Equipment centrifuge, complete with head, tubes, stand and carriers, the price of which is approximately \$414.50.

Inasmuch as the cut of \$300 for apparatus, equipment and supplies was not restored to the budget, I am suggesting that you try to have 4,000 mailing containers charged to the federal budget. The approximate cost of these containers, which we estimate is the amount required for the remainder of the year, is \$340. If you can have this charged against the federal budget, of course there will be no necessity for asking for \$300 in the supplementary budget.
