We purchase Gum Acacia, USP, #1 Powdered, in one-pound cans at \$1.11 per pound from McKesson Robbins, 385 Summer Street, Boston, Massachusetts. The product is put up by the S. V. Penick Company.

She also said that you were having some difficulty in reading Hinton tests. We strongly suggest that these tests be read under fluorescent lights. Many hospital technicians have had difficulty when they tried to read the test by daylight.

We hope the above suggestions will be of some help.
