Attached is the narrative report of the Wassermann laboratory (and statistical also) for fiscal period July 1, 1967 through June 30, 1968, as you requested.

ANNUAL REPORT COVERING PERIOD FROM
JULY 1, 1967 through JUNE 30, 1968

DURING fiscal year 1968 the Wassermann Laboratory performed 491,667 tests while processing 490,398 specimens - an increase of 12,264 tests over the previous year. In addition a total of 245,833 specimens were tested to comply with the premarital law, and 73,750 to comply with the prenatal law. Out-of-state premarital certificates were issued to 1910 applicants.

The intrastate evaluation of serologic test results for syphilis was conducted for approximately 200 local clinical laboratories and the Wassermann Laboratory participated, as usual, in the National Syphilis Serology Evaluation as well as the National Rabies Fluorescent Antibody Testing Survey. In both of these Federal-State programs the Wassermann Laboratory showed close agreement with results obtained by the National Communicable Disease Center.

Nineteen hundred and forty one tests were performed on six hundred and seventy two specimens that were examined for rabies. Of the total, five were found positive for rabies and all were bats:
