The actual number of square feet of floor space now used by the Wassermann Laboratory is as follows: 3,343, plus 200 feet for dead storage. We estimate that the minimum amount of space required for the satisfactory conduct of the work is 4,000 feet. I stress the word minimum because the plan of our present space is such that almost every inch of floor space has been most economically used.
