Dear Dr. Hinton:

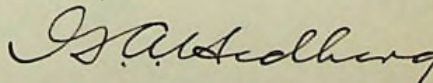
Doctor Laird has asked me to answer your letter with regards to the incidence of positive Wassermann tests amongst the patients at Nopeming.

I have taken a group of 1,000 consecutive admissions from the year of 1925 to 1930. I am enclosing a brief resume of the positive Wassermann's. You will note that of this 1,000; 29 had positive Wassermann's. Three were considered luetic who had negative Wassermann's. This would make our incidence approximately 3%. There were approximately ten negroes in this series, all of whom had negative Wassermann's.

However, treatment of luetics in the first part of this series was not followed consistently.

I am sorry that there has been this much delay in sending you this report.
